

“An Investigation of the therapeutic properties of Human Universal Energy (HUE) treatment, during External Beam Radiotherapy (EBRT) for early Stage Prostate and Breast Cancer”

The RAH Radiation Oncology Department are currently recruiting for early stage Prostate and Breast Cancer patients, to be involved in the following randomised trial using **Complementary Medicine in combination with Standard Radiation Therapy treatment**, which has been approved by the **RAH Research Ethics Committee**.

What is Human Universal Energy Healing?

HUE treatment is scientifically unproven. It is based on the belief of HUE practitioners that the human body and mind processes can be influenced when exposed to the **‘universal energy vibrations’** which they believe to be present around us.
