



What is it like to have a parent with cancer?

New research investigating what it is like for adults to have a parent with cancer is underway. The survey examines the following areas:

- Reactions to having a parent with cancer
- Psychological outcomes and well-being
- Involvement in caregiving – BUT if you couldn't help in caring you can still complete the survey.
